A LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Education Together Foundation (ETF) is proud, despite continued global challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic, to report another successful year for providing financial support to Junction City residents through educational grants, scholarships, and endowments. ETF would not be possible without the generous financial support from individual donors and businesses, or without the hard work of the volunteer board members and other volunteers. To learn more about ETF, please visit our website at jcetf.org and Facebook page. Our annual Awards Night took place on May 18, 2021 as our second Zoom presentation with Facebook Live audience attendance. A total of \$95,000 in scholarships and grants were awarded at this event and through the year. Of this, approximately 65 scholarships were awarded to students in college and technical fields. Community educational grants supported both young and old through reading programs at the local libraries, and senior computer skills. Since 1987, ETF has awarded over \$1,500,000! Tiger alumni continues to be a large part of ETF, having donating about \$30,000 this year and a history of donations of over \$275,000. "Go Tigers"! New for this year we have three new ETF board members Nicole Glazier ('98), Lillian Vaughan Moses ('04), and Liz Henderson ('01). Our ETF web site has been updated, with the help of Mae Swisher ('04), to include on-line applications for scholarships and grants along with a PayPal donation button to help ETF grow. Through the hard work of Pat Adelman, several new scholarships and annual endowments have been added this year. The ETF board has also made a commitment to communicate with all donors. Traci Collins has started a successful can/bottle drive for ETF. ETF has also initiated the goal, and challenges the Junction City community, to creating a total of 100 scholarships by 2025, just around the corner, and \$500,000 for the Alumni Endowed Fund. We know these are challenging times for everyone and that we will overcome current adversities to be stronger and wiser. In summary, it has been another successful year for ETF in fulfilling its mission of offering financial assistance for the purpose of providing educational opportunities for Junction City residents.


