#### A LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN

**Education Together Foundation** (ETF) is proud to report an outstanding 2021-2022 year of providing financial support to the Junction City community through educational grants, scholarships, and endowments. ETF would not be possible without the generous financial support from donors, JCHS alumni, and local businesses, or the hard work of the volunteer board members and other volunteers. We would like to commend Pam Fiske, Nancy Gifford, and Lynda Taylor for serving on the ETF board for 20 plus years and also welcome our one new board member Dr. Jackie Fabbi.

Our annual Awards Night took place in person on May 17, 2022. A total of \$139,420 in scholarships and grants were awarded at this event and through the year. Of this, 72 scholarships were awarded to students in college and technical fields. ETF educational grants are awarded throughout the year and help with multiple learning opportunities in the community. To date, since 1987, ETF has awarded over \$1,600,000! Tiger alumni continues to be a large part of ETF, having given over \$30,000 this year and a history giving over \$300,000. Through the hard work of Pat Adelman, several new scholarships and annual endowments have been added.

An ETF scholarship was also awarded as a first this year to a non-resident Junction City High School graduate. Although ETF has focused on Junction City School District residents in the past, the positive financial impact of non-resident Junction City High School graduates is significant, and from JCHS alumni contributions, is anticipated to be greater in the future. Therefore, the ETF board is taking steps to expand scholarship eligibility in the future to include not only Junction City School District residents but also all graduates from the Junction City School District #69 High School.

The mission of ETF remains to help the Junction City community become stronger and wiser through educational scholarships and grants and this year has been another great success. Thank you for your continued support towards reaching this mission.
